

# **This is a special release for REtool (RCtool) made with FileMaker Pro Advanced 14**

## **Installation**

1) Unpack the archive and move the REtool work folder, a subfolder named 'REtool', without changing anything to your Mac. The location does not matter as long it is a folder which belongs fully to you, e.g. do not move it into the Applications folder. It is recommended to move the REtool work folder to a folder where you do your Review Editor work.

2) You need to add to the REtool work folder following files from the latest update from RCtool Home & Downloads:

- REtool-main.fmpur (REtool work folder)
- REtool-textlinks.fmpur (REtool work folder)

3) It is recommended to add also following files downloaded from the DMS to the dedicated subfolders in the REtool work folder:

- To work with the meta data add the text links spreadsheet for your draft to subfolder '0-TAT-textlinks' and import the meta data. If you can get from the DMS a 'REtool-textlinks.fmpur' that contains already all meta data you need, then simply replace the 'REtool-textlinks.fmpur' in your REtool work folder with the one downloaded from the DMS. Yet, it might not hurt to keep a copy of the spreadsheet with the text links in your subfolder '0-TAT-textlinks'. You may wish to import those data at some later point in time, e.g. into a new version of the 'REtool-textlinks.fmpur'.
- To jump to PDFs add the properly named PDFs as downloaded to subfolder 'pdfs' of the respective draft
- To import Review Comments add the comments spreadsheet as downloaded to subfolder 'z1-Review Comments'

Note: ZOD stands for Zero Order Draft (Internal Draft), FOD for First Order Draft, SOD for Second Order Draft, and FGD for Final Government Draft.

## **System requirements**

This special release is offered for working with REtool (RCtool) on Macs using an older OS X. Following OS X are compatible:

- OS X 10.9.5 (Mavericks)
- OS X 10.10.5 (Yosemite)

plus

- OS X 10.11.6 (El Capitan)

For older systems I recommend to use the special release for REtool (RCtool) made with FileMaker Pro Advanced 12. While this release works fine under OS X 10.11.6 (El Capitan) for the latter or newer systems I recommend to use the latest release.
